Siesta Extra Brut, Col de Salici Rosé Prosecco, Gosset Champagne

Gruet Blanc de Noirs (New Mexico)

Glass 9 | Bottle 38

Complex and alluring bubbly with a creamy texture, light berry notes, and a toasty character. As Pink opines: 'Let's get this party started'.

Col de' Salici Rosé Prosecco Veneto (Italy)

Glass 10 | Bottle 42

Enjoy this elegant, exciting and aromatic sparkler with hints of berry and just a touch of sweetness. Festive and irresistibly fun. Cin Cin!

Ernesto Catena 'Siesta' Extra Brut Mendoza (Argentina)

Glass 12 | Bottle 50

Vivacious Argentine sparkler with Champagne-like finesse. Rich, dry and full of fresh pineapple and pear with a pleasant toastiness.

Roederer Estate Brut Rosé Andersen Valley (California)

Glass 14 | Bottle 60

Crisp and festive, with delicious cherry and graham cracker aromas with lively and rich strawberry, vanilla and spice flavors. Stunning.

Gosset Brut Champagne Excellence Reims (France)

Glass 18 | Bottle 76

Decadent and powerful yet balanced. Rich and toasty with notes of lemon, coconut and hazelnut with a long, dry and expressive finish.

Veuve Clicquot Brut Rosé Champagne Reims (France)

When only the best will do, celebrate in style with this luxurious pink masterpiece. Great intensity of flavor and an epiphany-inducing finish.

Domaine De Mourchon 'Séguret Loubié' Rosé

Côtes du Rhône-Villages 2009 (France)

½ Glass 5 | Glass 9 | Bottle 38

A lush, deeply hued rosé of Cinsault, Grenache & Syrah. Succulent notes of ripe cherry and vibrant strawberry with a touch of sweetness are balanced by crisp acidity and mineral. Think pink, Drink pink.

Fisher 'Unity' Rosé Sonoma County 2009 (California)

½ Glass 6 | Glass 11 | Bottle 46

California wine country summer in a glass. A refreshingly dry rosé of Syrah, bursting with juicy strawberry goodness. Pink is the new black, so try this wine on for size and watch as jealous looks abound.

Babcock Identity Crisis Syrah Santa Barbara 2009 (CA)

½ Glass 5 | Glass 9 | Bottle 38

Not quite white, nor rosé either, just 100% awesome. Crisp, racy and dry with an alluring peach hue giving way to mysteriously delicious notes of watermelon, apricot and creamy spice. Dare to be different.

Condesa Eylo Verdejo Rueda 2008 (Spain)

½ Glass 5 | Glass 9 | Bottle 38

Refreshing and lively, highlighting the hidden delight of Verdejo. Step out of your comfort zone and you'll be rewarded with bright lemon-lime and fresh acidity coupled with intriguing floral and honey undertones.

Wild Rock 'Elevation' Sauvignon Blanc

Marlborough 2008 (New Zealand)

½ Glass 5 | Glass 10 | Bottle 42

Classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc. A mouthwatering and enticing blast of grapefruit, guava and gooseberry with a long, lingering finish.

Domaine de la Perriere Sancerre, Loire Valley 2009 (France)

½ Glass 7 | Glass 13 | Bottle 56

Sancerre is French for really awesome Sauvignon Blanc with racy acidity, zingy lemon citrus, steely minerality and floral aromas. Impress your friends and your taste buds.

Simonsig Chenin Blanc 2010 (South Africa)

½ Glass 4 | Glass 7 | Bottle 30

Explore the wonderful citrus and yellow apple infused world of this S. African charmer. Plus, we traveled 12,000 miles to bring you this gem.

Ponzi Pinot Gris Willamette Valley 2009 (Oregon)

½ Glass 5 | Glass 10 | Bottle 42

THE white grape of Oregon. This seductress flaunts her perfectly juicy grapefruits and succulent pears. And unlike Bernie Madoff, this Ponzi schemes only to tantalize your taste buds.

Brokenwood 'Cricket Pitch' Hunter Valley 2007 (Australia)

Sauvignon Blanc/Semillon

½ Glass 5 | Glass 9 | Bottle 38

How do you make sauv blanc better? Simply add half semillon. Honeysuckle, lemony citrus, melon and a touch of fresh cut herbs intertwine to produce a bright, crisp and lively Aussie beauty.

Vigneti Massa Timorasso Piemonte 2008 (Italy)

½ Glass 7 | Glass 14 | Bottle 56

This fuller-bodied, voluptuous elixir evokes the spirit of the red head on Mad Men – stunning, memorable and alluring. Complex minerality and focused acidity keeps all the body in harmonious balance. The best wine you've never heard of. Geek out your wine palette.

Baumard Savennières Loire Valley 2006 (France)

½ Glass 7 | Glass 13 | Bottle 56

Contemplative, complex, dry and immensely appealing with white peach, melon and floral flavors intermingling with stony, mineral and chalky notes. Textbook Loire Valley Chenin Blanc.

Berger Grüner Veltliner Kremstal 2009 (Austria)

½ Glass 5 | Glass 9 | Bottle 45 (1 liter bottle, 6.5 glasses)

The ultimate summer sipper. This fun-loving and whimsical Austrian songstress is crisp and refreshing with a juicy blast of citrus. Sing it Julie: 'The hills are alive, with the sound of music'.

Swanson Pinot Grigio Napa Valley 2008 (California)

½ Glass 5 | Glass 10 | Bottle 42

From this Napa stalwart comes an intoxicatingly fresh veil of mouthwatering lemon, pear and lychee – all backed by a smooth roundness that makes this wine an Italian-inspired dream.

Robert Foley Pinot Blanc Napa Valley 2008 (California)

½ Glass 7 | Glass 13 | Bottle 56

Crisp, yet supple with intoxicating notes of Asian pear, almond and spice that linger on the palette. What about Bob? Well, he makes some of the best wine in the Napa Valley. That's what Bob's all about.

Burgans Albariño Rias Baixas 2008 (Spain)

½ Glass 5 | Glass 9 | Bottle 38

Zesty, crisp and vibrant with juicy tangerine, lemon and melon flavors. Bored by the average and boring? Give your taste buds a thrill ride.

Frisk 'Prickly' Riesling Victoria 2009 (Australia)

½ Glass 4 | Glass 8 | Bottle 34

Generous sweet lemon sorbet and lime balanced with racy acidity, a refreshing light spritz and a long, persistent finish. This frisky wine will tickle your tongue and energize your palette. Frisk me all over please.

K Vintners Viognier Columbia Valley 2009 (Washington)

½ Glass 6 | Glass 12 | Bottle 52

This immensely alluring and sexy wine bursts with notes of fresh picked peach, hints of mineral and spice. Even better, the winemaker and owner Charles Smith was a former rock band manager in Europe.

Glen Carlou Chardonnay Paarl 2008 (South Africa)

½ Glass 5 | Glass 9 | Bottle 38

Lush and toasty, displaying intoxicating notes of pear, quince and fig melded with creamy vanilla and brioche. The official athlete's drink of the 2010 World Cup - well no, but it should have.

Fort Ross 'Fort Ross Vineyard' Chardonnay

Sonoma Coast 2008 (California)

½ Glass 6 | Glass 12 | Bottle 52

Showcasing a new movement in balanced Chardonnay, this complex beauty is medium-bodied with lively acidity and a judicious use of oak. Notes of citrus, spicy pear and lemon mingle with a light creaminess.

Simonnet-Febvre Chablis Vaillons 1er Cru

Burgundy 2006 (France)

½ Glass 7 | Glass 14 | Bottle 60

White Burgundy is the nectar of the Gods. This luxurious and svelte madmoiselle d'amour from the famed Chablis appellation seamlessly blends peach and melon notes with subtle minerality and fresh acidity.
